

This is an agreement between
Diocese of Livingstone
and
Mr. Ranko Tadić
representing the organization called
Ekonjimo.

Terms of the Agreement:

1. Ekonjimo rents house No. 2 from Njoko Mission starting from 1. January, 2016 to 31. December 2017 with no rent payment.
2. In place of rent payment for the first two years, Ekonjimo has an obligation to furnish the house with solar light and solar freezer (Steca 166l). Minimum capacity of solar modules should be 160W and battery capacity 400Ah. Ekonjimo also supplies minimum of two beds with bedding, and house furniture like table and chairs, kitchen stoves: 1 wood stove and a gas stove with all kitchen utensils, kitchen zinc, etc.
3. After 31. December, 2017, the rent payment will be fixed by the Diocese of Livingstone.
4. Ekonjimo will contribute to existing water system for its maintenance amounting to USD200 per annum starting from 1. January 2016. Any further improvement of house water supply is the responsibility of Ekonjimo.
5. Njoko Mission or the Diocese of Livingstone does not take responsibility for theft or any other damage to Ekonjimo.
6. The house will be used for the programs of promoting agriculture only and not for any other purposes and it will not be sub rented to other occupants. The occupants of the house will comply with values of the Mission and rules issued by the Mission Authorities.
7. Any further desired improvement of the house must be approved by the Mission.
